Gonadorelin, a synthetic GnRH analogue, mirrors endogenous pituitary signaling required for luteinizing hormone (LH) and follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH) release. Human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG) has a long-standing association with gonadal stimulation due to its LH-like structure. Testagen aligns with traditional organotherapy principles supporting tissue-specific endocrine signaling.

Mechanistic Rationale

- Kisspeptin supports hypothalamic initiation of reproductive signaling
- Gonadorelin mirrors endogenous GnRH communication with the pituitary
- hCG aligns with LH-like gonadal stimulation
- Testagen supports tissue-specific testicular signaling

Prepared at a 6C homeopathic dilution, Happy SAC emphasizes regulatory signaling rather than direct hormone replacement. The ethyl alcohol base facilitates sublingual absorption and product stability.
